Fostoria Railfan Park - Under Construction - This is the former junkyard and slaughterhouse, which have been removed and the site is being prepared for the planned park. Limited parking and "facilities" are to be available starting in 2008; other amenities are planned as funds become available.

Downtown Fostoria

Most fast-food restaurants and gas stations (and a K-Mart for film) are on US 23 northwest of downtown - follow the signs to US 23 - County Line Road.

Dell's Restaurant on Main St., 3 blocks north of the Amtrak Station, is good and reasonable.

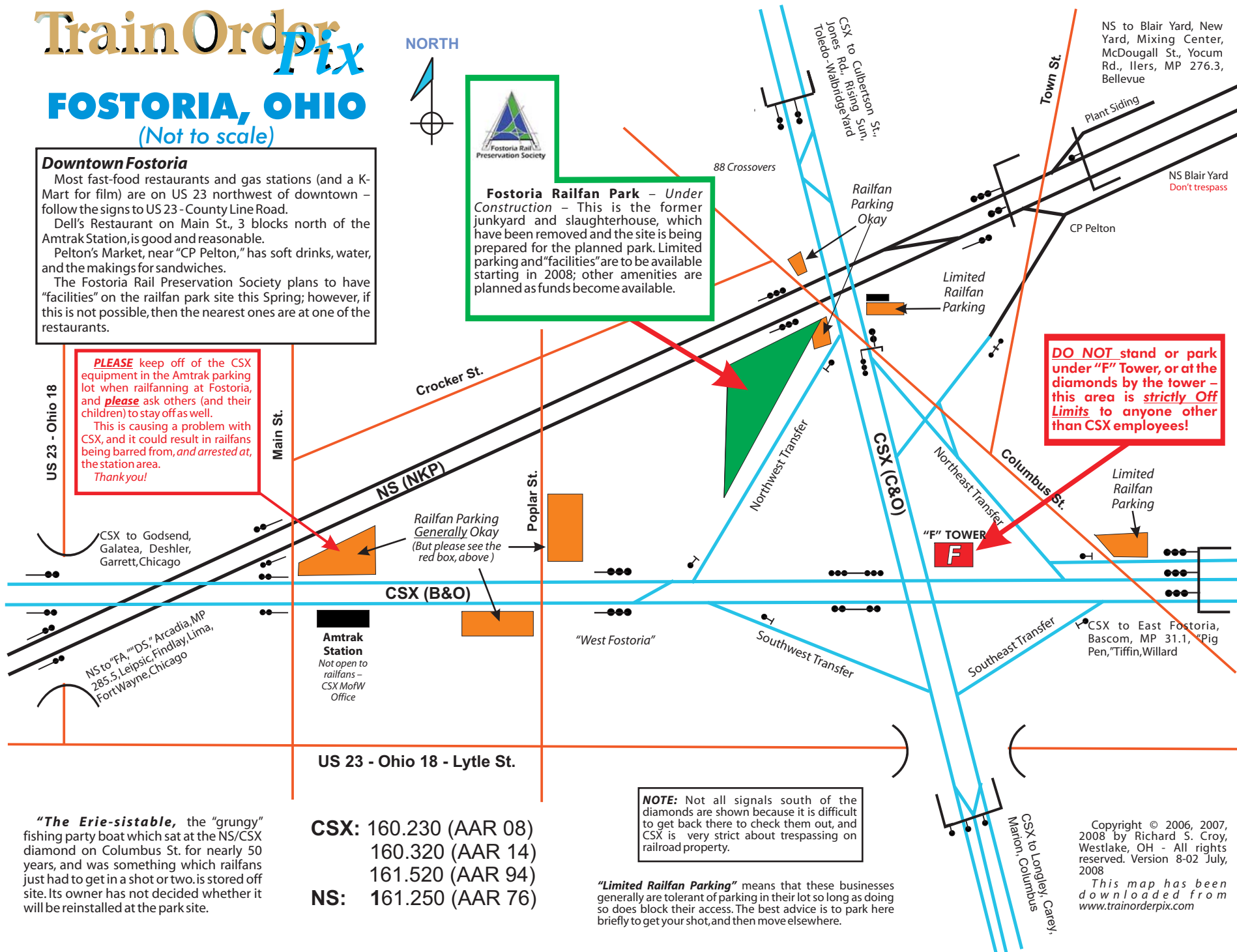
Pelton's Market, near "CP Pelton," has soft drinks, water, and the makings for sandwiches.

The Fostoria Rail Preservation Society plans to have "facilities" on the railfan park site this Spring; however, if this is not possible, then the nearest ones are at one of the restaurants.

PLEASE keep off of the CSX equipment in the Amtrak parking lot when railfanning at Fostoria, and **please** ask others (and their children) to stay off as well.

This is causing a problem with CSX, and it could result in railfans being barred from, and arrested at, the station area.

DO NOT stand or park under "F" Tower, or at the diamonds by the tower - this area is **strictly Off Limits** to anyone other than CSX employees!



"The Erie-sistable, the "grungy" fishing party boat which sat at the NS/CSX diamond on Columbus St. for nearly 50 years, and was something which railfans just had to get in a shot or two. is stored off site. Its owner has not decided whether it will be reinstalled at the park site.

- 160.320 (AAR 14)
- 161.520 (AAR 94)
- NS: 161.250 (AAR 76)

NOTE: Not all signals south of the diamonds are shown because it is difficult to get back there to check them out, and CSX is very strict about trespassing on railroad property.

"Limited Railfan Parking" means that these businesses generally are tolerant of parking in their lot so long as doing so does not block their access. The best advice is to park here briefly to get your shot, and then move elsewhere.
